

## **NEW – GOOGLE SEARCH ENGINE**

HGF is pleased to announce a new search tab provided free by *Google* replacing the former search tab on the home page. This search tab located above the home page graphic images searches only the public portion of the site.

After logging in to the member only portion of the site, both search tabs can be used and will generally produce different results (both applicable to your search term). This is explained further below.

The new search tab enables anyone to search databases and information based on the public side of the HGF web site. For a short while, some page links may found but because they are on the member only portion of the web site, the Message “**Page cannot be found**” may be encountered. As always, HGF members once logged in will be able to access any and all data as usual. This message will generally only relate for a short while and once Google recognizes the errors, the message will eventually go away.

## **NEW – BIBLE TRANSCRIPTION PROJECT**

The HGF / HBU Bible transcription project can now be found and searched with this new Search tab also One of the Bibles is listed as an examples to show how this new search engine works. However, examples will also apply to all member area searching.

Example: Bible # **06.68** includes information from the **CUNE** Family. Search for the word **CUNE** (not case sensitive) and you will be able to open the actual Excel transcription files and image files for this Bible. The Excel file has 7 different sheets (or tabs) of information, which are labeled. The photographed Bible pages are found on the last sheet of the Excel files.

**Give it a test.** If you find your family line within any of these Bibles, contact Houston Baptist University’s Dunham Bible Museum directly to make arrangements to see the actual Bible.
