Then off to a delicious lunch with 60 foot ceilings and a Dixieland Band (usually) at Christ Church Cathedral. Finally, tour the oldest part of Houston, Frost Town with noted historian Kirk Farris. You'll be back to your car in time to miss rush hour traffic.

Lunch at Christ Church Cathedral (Treebeard's Cafeteria) is not included in \$12 fee.

The bus will begin loading at 9:00am at Bayland Community Center, 6400 Bissonnet Street (at the tennis courts), and depart at 9:30 am, and will return to Bayland at approximately 3:30 to 4 pm.
